# Community Groups/Organisations

## Monbulk Primary School

Monbulk Primary School has been dedicated to sustainability since 2015. The school has achieved certification in all five Resource Smart Schools modules: Core, Energy, Waste, Water, and Biodiversity. In December 2023, Sustainability Victoria awarded Monbulk Primary School a prestigious 5-star rating for its outstanding sustainability efforts. The school community, including staff, students, and families, actively participates in various environmental initiatives, such as biodiversity audits, native plantings, water conservation, and waste reduction and diversion programs. Monbulk Primary School continues to inspire and educate its community on the importance of environmental stewardship. This term, Grade 5-6 students will create a to-scale model envisioning a sustainable Monbulk in 25-50 years, which will be presented at the Repower Festival.



## Yarra Ranges Council

In 2019, Yarra Ranges Council recognised the pressing global climate emergency and called for immediate action from all government levels. By 2020, council unveiled the Liveable Climate Plan with ambitious targets: net zero emissions by 2040 (60% reduction by 2025), 100% renewable energy by 2030, and eliminating operational energy costs by 2040. The climate action team has been diligently working to enhance energy and water efficiency across council assets, upgrade buildings in townships to create emergency hubs, collaborate with local groups on energy resilience projects, and much more. In 2025, council has proudly supported the organisation of the Repower Festival in Monbulk.

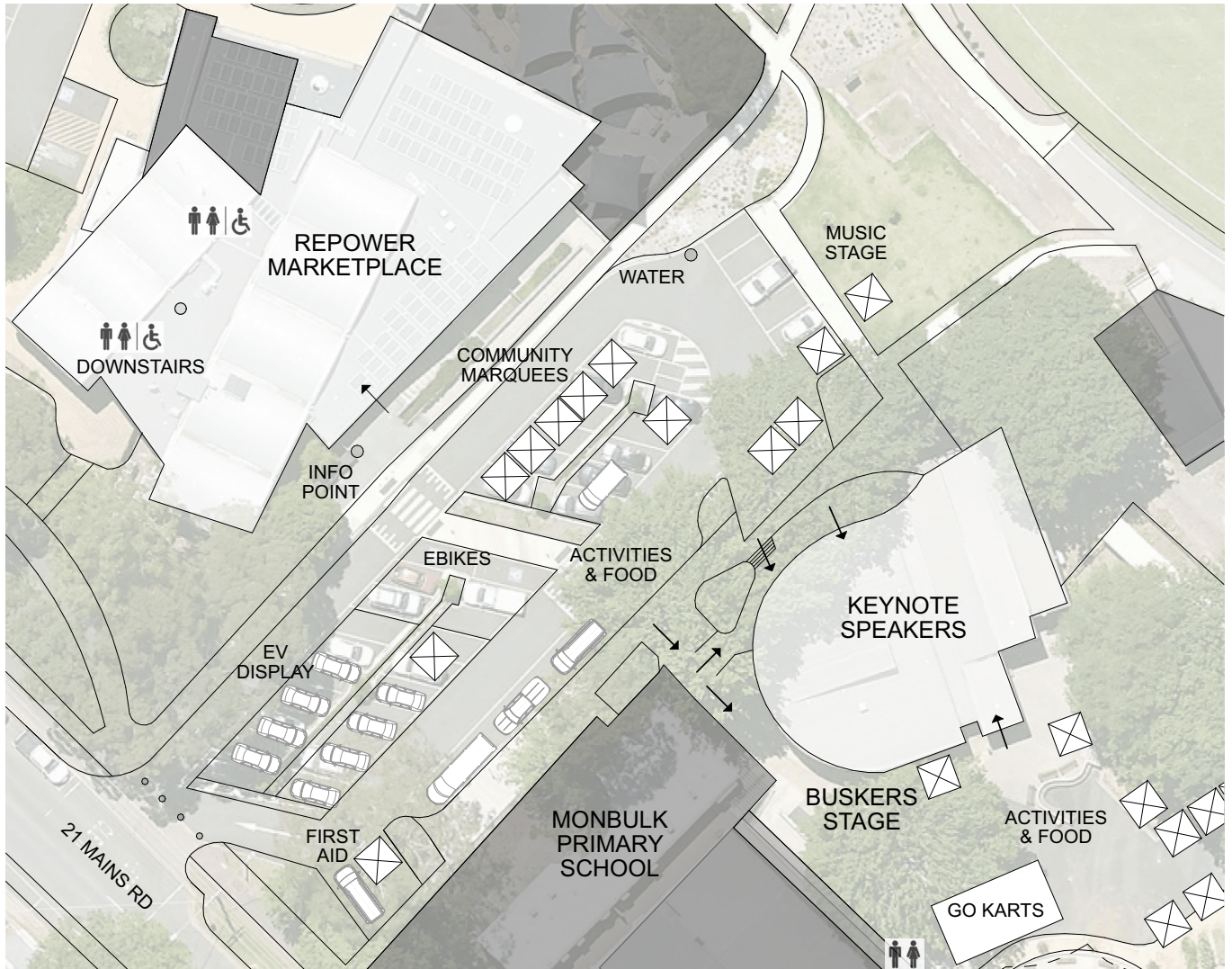

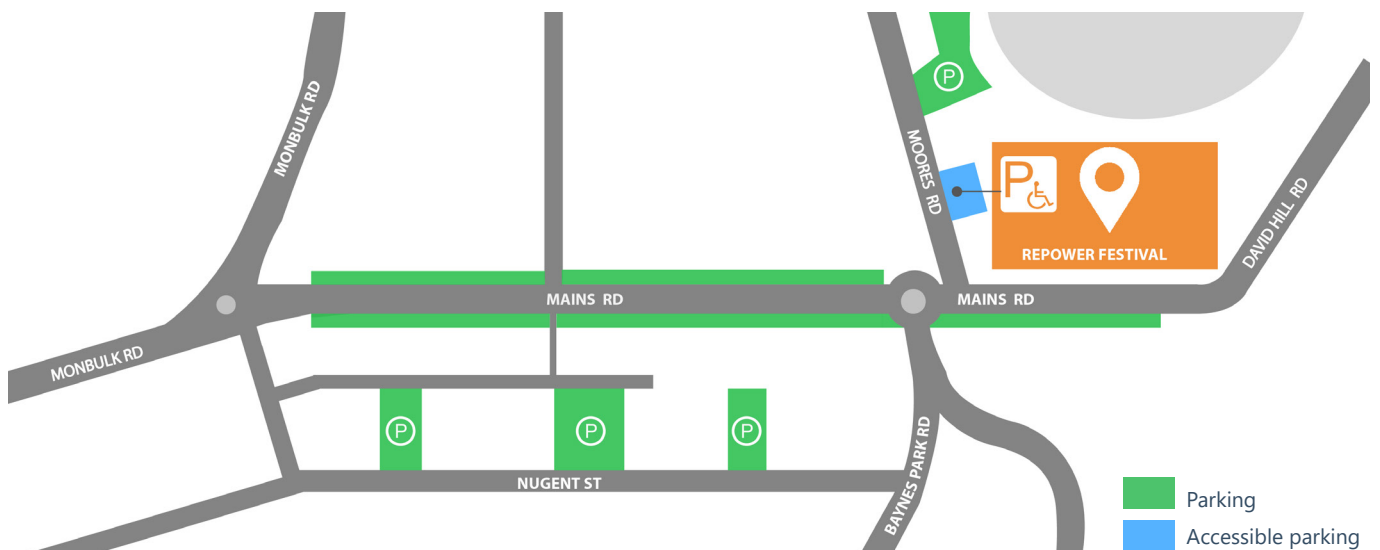


# Site Map

Lily D'Ambrosio, a member of the Australian Labor Party, has represented Mill Park in the Victorian Legislative Assembly since 2002. She has served as Minister for various portfolios, including Community Development, Industry, and Environment. Notably, she is Australia's longest-serving current Minister for Energy since 2014 and is also the Minister for Climate Action, Energy and Resources, and State Electricity Commission. She led the passage of Victoria's Climate Change Act, aiming for net zero emissions by 2045. Under her leadership, Victoria has seen significant reductions in greenhouse gas emissions and set ambitious targets for renewable energy and emissions reduction.

Prior to entering Parliament, Daniela owned and managed an organic grocery store for over six years until March 2022.
